# East Alton Skating Academy Learn-to-Skate Classes

The East Alton Skating Academy will offer Spring Learn-to skate classes March 23rd—May 11th, 2011. Classes will be held on Wednesday evenings between 6pm and 7pm. The session will last 8 weeks, concluding with the 1st Annual Riverbend Spring Classic. Each class will be thirty minutes long (6-6:30pm & 6:30-7pm). The cost of the 8-week session will be \$110 for all new skaters. This price will include: 30 minutes of instruction and skating each week, skate rental (if needed), and a yearly membership to US Figure Skating! (If skaters participated in Summer I, II, or Fall 2010 Session the price is \$100!) **REGISTRATION FORMS ARE DUE March 20th! ANY FORMS TURNED IN AFTER THIS DATE WILL RESULT IN**



**A \$10 LATE FEE!** There will be **NO REFUNDS** offered, unless the class must be cancelled due to low enrollment, or an emergency situation.

After registering for classes, you will be contacted via email/phone letting you know your exact class time. Please include your email for ease of communication on all skating events!

The Spring LTS will conclude with the Riverbend Spring Classic competition. Each skater will be given the opportunity to compete in a compulsory event!

### Snowplow 1-3:

This class is for those skaters 3-5 years old. They will begin their class learning to skate with a bucket and graduate to basic skating moves by the end of the session.

### Basic 1-8:

These classes are offered to those skaters 6-16. Skaters will begin with basic skating skills and will learn more difficult skills while progressing through the levels.

### Jumps, Spins, & More:

This class is for any skater Basic 4 or above. Skaters will learn basic jumps & spins, as well as other skating moves. This is a great class for anyone interested in competing or advancing into freestyle. \*This class will meet off ice at 10:50am every Saturday prior to taking the ice. \*\*Class should be take in addition to regular level class.
